PRIMARY PURPOSE

Seeking commercial cabinet shop assemblers, installers, finishers and helpers

TYPICAL DUTIES

- Assembly of commercial grade cabinets, as well as plastic laminate countertops and solid surface countertops
- Installation of commercial grade cabinet, as well as plastic laminate countertops and solid surface countertops
- Reading blueprints to identify necessary size and dimensions of product you are working on
- Lamination of cabinets including flush trim routing and filing
- Installing required hardware on cabinets
- Keeping a clean, organized work environment
- Perform other duties as necessary and directed by supervisor, to include, but not be limited to working on site trash pick-up, tool/supply room or warehouse attendant, and following all safety requirements

REQUIREMENTS

Worker must be able to:

- Meet standard job requirements.
- Perform a variety of duties.
- Rate information using standards that can be measured or checked.
- Work within precise standards of accuracy.
- Compare and see differences in size, shape, and form of lines, figures, and objects.
- Look at flat drawings or pictures and understand how they would look as solid objects.
- Follow oral, and written directions, plans, and blueprints.
- Apply shop mathematics to solve problems.
- Experience with the following tools is preferred. Table saw, edge bander, routers, miter saw, drill.

Physically, workers must be able to:

- Stand or walk for long periods.
- Use arms and hands to reach for, handle, and manipulate objects.
- Regularly lift and carry materials weighing up to 50 pounds.
- Stoop, kneel, crouch, and crawl.
- See and hear well (naturally or with correction).
- Work in non-climate controlled facility
